

The English Archery Federation

The English Archery Federation (EAF) is a body set up by the five English Regions within The Grand National Archery Society (GNAS) to select and manage teams for International events where it is appropriate for England (as opposed to Great Britain) to participate.

The Regions also require EAF to run National tournaments and administer such English Awards deemed appropriate (e.g. English Crosses)

To qualify to represent England (and not Great Britain) you must have submitted your scores in accordance with the current selection criteria

To be eligible to shoot for England an archer must be a member of an English club affiliated to GNAS via one of the five English regions.

He/she should not have shot for Great Britain since the date of the previous shoot for the discipline and event under consideration.

You will only be considered for selection for an English team if you submit your scores on the OFFICIAL FORM (word format) or .pdf file by the deadlines as laid down.

A minimum of Three (3) Scores Must be submitted in all cases

****** Weighting will be given to scores submitted from the current outdoor season when applying for selection to represent England.**

Senior Indoor Tournaments

Fita18, or Fita25 record status rounds shot **since Monday following the National Indoor (i.e. 9th December 2013)**

Senior Outdoor Euronations / International Tournaments including Commonwealth Archery Championships Europe

(except Commonwealth Games see CG2010 page)

UK Record Status 1440 or WRS 1440 (previously Fita star) **shot from the Monday following the previous years tournament i.e.15th July 2013**

at least one score must be shot in the current season.

Senior Outdoor Home Nations Tournaments (British Championships)

UK Record Status 1440 or WRS 1440 (previously Fita star) **shot from the Monday following the previous years tournament i.e.12th August 2013**

at least one score must be shot in the current season.

Junior Outdoor Euronations/International Tournaments

UK Record Status 1440 or WRS 1440 (previously Fita star), Fita 900, or Metric rounds, appropriate to age or above,

shot from the Monday following the previous years tournament i.e. 12th August 2013.

One Fita 70 or Fita 60 (according to age group) or Fita 50 (compound) may be included as well as two 12 dozen rounds.

at least one score must be shot in the current season.

Junior Outdoor Home Nations Tournaments (National Junior Championships Weekend)

UK Record Status- WA 1440, WRS WA 1440 (previously Fita star), or Metric rounds, appropriate to age or above

shot from the Monday following the previous years tournament i.e.(8th July 2013)

at least one score must be shot in the current season.

Junior Indoor Tournaments

Record status - Fita18, Fita25, or Portsmouth rounds shot since the **Monday following the Junior National Indoor (i.e. 9th December 2013).**

All British Field Championships

Team will be taken from those that have entered the competition. Using the highest ranked in each discipline.
